## About DADAA

Over 25 years of practice, DADAA has brought together Community Arts and Cultural Development (CACD), Arts and Disability, Arts and Health and regional art practices, supporting thousands of artists with disability and their communities to create new work which gives voice to and emphasises cultural inclusion, drives diverse responses and changes how people think about lived experiences of disability and mental health.

DADAA operates from three arts and community centres, Fremantle, Midland, and Lancelin, alongside delivering our programs across Western Australia, national and internationally.

## About the Side Gallery

The Side Gallery is a new exhibition space at DADAA Fremantle. The Side Gallery will feature a monthly program of exhibitions, with a focus on artists working within DADAA's arts program, or artists with a lived experience of disability and/or a mental illness.

This space aims to create opportunities for first time exhibitors or artists wishing to showcase a body of work that they have had in development. Open to all mediums, works will be selected from artists through an via an application process.

## Additional Side Gallery Information

### Terms

- Exhibitions in the Side Gallery are free for DADAA artists and clients.
- If you are not a DADAA artist or client a fee for use of Side Gallery will apply of \$100 per week. This fee will need to be paid two weeks prior to the exhibition.
- DADAA can manage sale of artworks. DADAA will take a commission fee of 20% for all artwork sales.
- Installation of artworks will be completed by DADAA staff.
- Promotion of the exhibition may take place via the DADAA website, mailing list and social media.
- Selection of exhibitions is at the sole discretion of the Side Gallery Coordinator and selection panel.

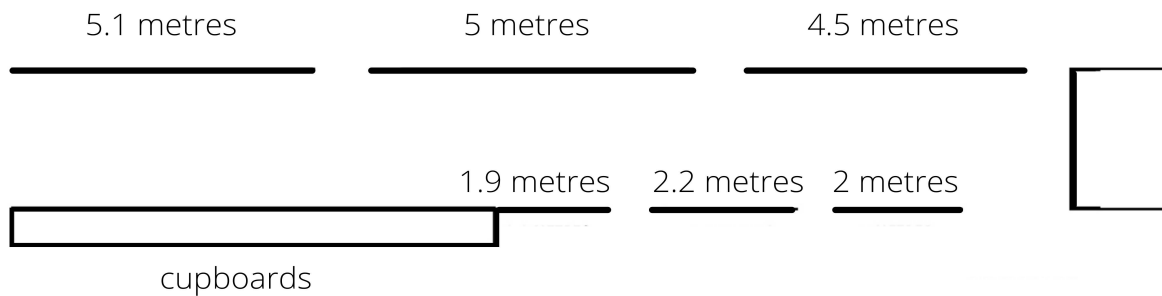
## Specifications and available equipment

## Exhibiting Artists' Responsibilities

- Successful applicants will be required to sign an agreement with DADAA related to the exhibition.
- If required to pay a hire fee, applicants must pay the fee no later than two weeks prior to the exhibition.
- Supply at least one print-quality image relating to the project for promotional purposes.
- Provide a 150-200 word project description and up to 150-word artist bio.
- Ensure delivery of artworks to DADAA on the dates specified.
- Please communicate with DADAA Side Gallery Coordinator in regard to artwork information, equipment and installation requirements.
